### ROUTE 4 BRIDGE OVER PALISADE AVENUE, WINDSOR ROAD AND CSX RAILROAD BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT Teaneck Township, Bergen County, NJ

The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT), committed to developing transportation improvements that best balance transportation needs, the environment, community concerns and costs, will hold a **Virtual Public Information Center (PIC)** to provide local residents, public officials, and the business community with information on the **Route 4 Bridge over Palisade Avenue, Windsor Road, and CSX Railroad Bridge Improvement** project. #### BACKGROUND

The purpose of the project is to address the poor structural conditions of the Route 4 Bridge over Palisade Avenue, Windsor Road, and CSX Railroad Bridge. The bridge is located on Route 4 from Mile post 6.95 to 7.03. It is an eight-span structure measuring at 495 feet in length at 78.8 feet wide. The bridge has two 12' travel lanes with a 6' shoulder in the eastbound direction and three 10' lanes traveling westbound.

#### THE PROPOSED PROJECT

The proposed project includes the following:

- The structurally deficient bridge will be replaced with a five span bridge at 505' long and 102.5' wide.
- The new bridge will accommodate three 11' lanes in each direction (EB will be two through lanes and one auxiliary lane) with 10' shoulders and a 7' sidewalk on the south side of the structure.
- Existing public utilities along Route 4 will be relocated to local roads.

#### TRAFFIC CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

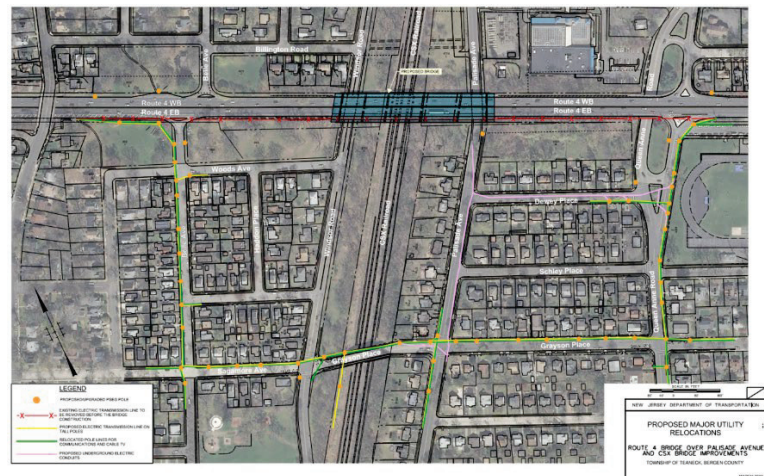
The Route 4 bridge replacement will be performed in three main stages. Two lanes of traffic along both bounds will be maintained in all three stages. The sidewalk will be closed in stage 3 and pedestrian detour provided. Short detours on side streets may be required during utility relocations.

#### PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction Start: Spring 2027

Utility Relocation: Summer 2027 – Summer 2029

Bridge Construction: Summer 2029 – Fall 2033
